The Year 1994 raised the hopes of many people in South Africa for change and for the fulfilment of their dreams.

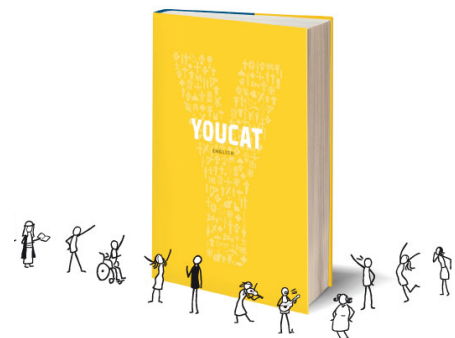

AFRIKAANS ALTAR MISSAL & LECTIONARIES

The revision of the Afrikaans Altar Missal has begun and a new edition should be print-ready by Advent 2017. Publication should coincide with the publication of the Volgende Vertaling van die Bybel in Afrikaans, an ecumenical Liturgical translation of sacred Scripture coordinated by the Bible Society of South Africa and supported by all the mainline Churches which use Afrikaans in their Liturgy.

As a result of the two projects, the revision of the Afrikaans Altar Missal and the Volgende Vertaling van die Bybel in Afrikaans, the Altar Missal (Afrikaans) as well as the three volume Afrikaans Lectionaries will have to be reprinted ± from 2017 onward.
