• Diploma in General nursing.

- Qualification in Community Nursing Science will be an added advantage.
- Current registration with South African Nursing Council as a Professional Nurse.
- At least 5 years' experience after qualification as a registered nurse.
- At least 3 years exposure on project management working with NGOs.
- Experience with donor-funded projects.
- Skills and knowledge related to the HIV and AIDS environment.
- Experience in training and mentoring of professional nurses and community workers at grassroots/diocesan organizations (community based organizations).
- Proficiency in English and one or more local languages.
- Computer Proficiency in MS Office Suite and Outlook.
- A valid driver's license.
- Knowledge of the teachings of the Catholic Church.

Duties Include:

- Recruit and train professional nurses for deployment to the districts
- Support and supervise the nurses deployed to the districts.
- Develop and disseminate site specific work plans to ensure targets are met for HIV testing, referral for treatment and for treatment adherence.
- Coordinate & monitor program in collaboration with Program Manager.
- Address program quality improvement issues for effective service delivery.
- Work closely with Department of Health Structures and other stakeholders.
